

Scholarship Information

Annual Scholarships are awarded to assist a recipient pursuing a career in a health-related educational program at an accredited college, university or health-related technical school in the state of Georgia.

The Sally M. Johnson scholarship pro-gram is paid directly to the college to pay for tuition, fees, or books.

Cherokee county high school seniors and persons currently enrolled in an educational institution must apply directly to the Northside Hospital Cherokee Auxiliary committee.

The scholarship is for tuition only and each applicant is considered on an individual basis and merit. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the tuition office of the educational institution if it meets the criteria as stated in the Auxiliary Scholarship Requirements.

What is Required in the Scholarship Application?

Eligibility criteria for Northside Hospital Cherokee Auxiliary Scholarship:

- Be pursuing a degree or certificate in the healthcare profession
- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Submit an official high school or college transcript
- Be enrolled or submit official proof of acceptance in an accredited educational institution in the state of Georgia
- Be classified as: resident of Cherokee County, a volunteer or employed at NSC, or be a dependent of an employee of NSC
- Be a citizen of the USA or be a permanent resident of the USA (proof of visa will be required)
- Scholarship awards will be based on the applicant's:
Participation in Student and Community Activities, Scholastic records, character, qualities of leadership, and letters of recommendation
- Participate in an interview
- Grant written permission for name and photo to be published
- The Scholarship Awardee is highly encouraged to attend the annual Northside Hospital Cherokee Auxiliary luncheon in July.
- Completed application must be received by April 1, 2020
